

Mobile Slaughter Unit

Mobile slaughter and mobile chilling unit for the Samoan Government

he Wulguru Group have been approached by the Samoan Government to manufacture a mobile slaughter unit and associated mobile chilling unit for use in the processing of beef cattle. This project is designed to provide a simple and hygienic slaughter system for use in rural areas of Samoa.

These units are to be capable of hanging and chilling up to 6 head (3 in each) and are designed to hold all elements needed to efficiently slaughter cattle including knives, tools, lifting equipment, water tanks, sterilising units, generators, refrigeration units, etc.

Under the appointment the Wulguru Group are responsible for designing, fabricating and commissioning the units as well as providing training to Samoan locals in it's use. The design has now been finalised and the units are now nearing manufacture completion. Commissioning and training is to be undertaken in early 2016.

This is an exciting export project for the Wulguru Group and the first time we have entered into a contract signed by a current serving Prime Minister of a country! We will include photos of the completed project in our next newsletter.
